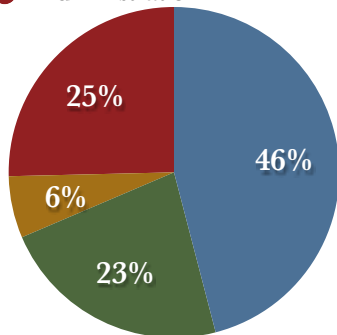

Youth Programs- Center Programming, Drop In Center, Groups, Special Events, Community Trainings, Transgender Outreach

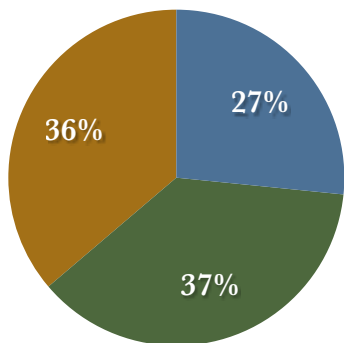
2,370 sign in for drop in space

\$5,000 Pays for an **LGBTQ youth advocacy camp** for 30 youth so they can learn how to make their schools and communities safer spaces for all youth.
